Dear peer reviewer to review the paper it is a must to establish in advance what kind of paper has been assigned for your reviewing, this in order to meet the necessary conditions stated by Colciencias:

Dear peer reviewer, in order to continue with the paper review, the type of paper must be stated in advance. Please select what that type of paper was assigned for your review, this in order to know in advance the quality conditions that should be met according to Colciencias in the paper.

<b>SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL RESEARCH PAPER.</b>	A document that presents in detail, the original results of completed research projects. The structure most generally used is composed by four major sections: introduction, methodology, results and conclusions.
<b>REFLECTION PIECE.</b>	A document that presents the results of completed research from an analytical, interpretative or critical perspective of the author, on a specific subject, from original sources.
<b>REVIEW PAPER.</b>	A Paper that is a result of a completed research project, it presents, analyses, systematized and integrated results of a research published or unpublished, about a field of science or technology, in order to give an account of the findings and trends in the field. It is characterized by presenting a careful bibliographical revision of at least 50 documents cited.
<b>SHORT PAPER.</b>	Short paper that presents preliminary or partial original results of a scientific or technological research that generally require a quick dissemination.
<b>CASE STUDY</b>	A document that presents the results of a study on a particular situation in order to disseminate the technical and methodological experiences developed in a specific case. It includes a systematic and well commented review of the literature on similar cases.
<b>REVIEW ARTICLE.</b>	Outcome document of the critical review of the literature on a particular subject.
<b>LETTERS TO THE EDITOR.</b>	Critical, analytical or interpretative positions on the documents published in the magazine, which, in the opinion of the editorial board, it constitutes an important contribution to the discussion of the subject by the scientific community.
<b>EDITORIAL.</b>	Document written by the editor, a member of the editorial board or a guest researcher on guidelines in the thematic domain of the “revista de estudios latinoamericanos” magazine.
<b>TRANSLATION.</b>	Translations of classical texts, topical, contemporary or transcripts of historical documents, or documents of particular interest in the domain of the “revista de estudios latinoamericanos” journal.
<b>NON RESEARCH RELATED REFLECTION PIECE.</b>	Academic paper product of a critical: assessment-and-evaluation of a particular academic subject of interest and social applicability.
<b>BIBLIOGRAFICAL NOTICE</b>	Report on the contents and characteristics of a book or any publication.
<b>ESSAY</b>	Paper, which is a Result of a critical analysis and discussion of a subject, supported by a rigorous literature review, in which a substantial contribution is made on the weaknesses, strengths and opportunities for inquiry and Research of the subject upon which it is reflecting, analyzing or reviewing.
